SPECIAL NOTE: Regardless of the excerpt you choose to perform, the judges will place you in a group of musicians who perform at a similar level. For example, depending upon the quality of your audition, if you perform a Pikes Peak Winds trumpet excerpt, you may be placed in Bravo or maybe Ovation. Or, if you choose a trumpet excerpt from Ovation, you may still be placed in Pikes Peak Winds. Only one audition is needed for placement in a group. **When selecting audition excerpts, select ones you can play well now**. Remember, it is better to play a simpler excerpt well than to perform a difficult excerpt badly.

Additional Information

- Full orchestras consist of woodwinds, brass, percussion, and strings.
- o Bands consist of woodwinds, brass, and percussion.
- String orchestras consist of strings only.
- Harp and piano positions are only available for the Youth Symphony.
- There is a \$10 non-refundable fee payable at the time of the audition.
- Plan to arrive 15-20 minutes prior to your audition time in order to get checked in and warm up.
- For string musicians who are not quite ready for our auditioned groups, CSYSA offers a beginning strings program for students with little to no experience. Information can be found on our website - <u>Mozart Strings</u> Project.
